

The mandate of the GW OHT Steering Committee is to understand the health of the GW OHT priority populations including health equity and social determinants of health and lead transformational system change for the GW OHT population.
- GW OHT Governance Council <u>Dr. Ian Digby</u> represents GWPA at this monthly meeting of the Board of Governors representatives from each of the GW OHT Direct Core Partners. GW OHT Governance Council provides governance oversight for the GW OHT.
- GW OHT Working Group—Privacy & Stewardship <u>Dr. Kevin Samson</u> is Physician Lead for this group which supports the development of the foundational infrastructure and culture within GW OHT to ensure information such as patient charts and digital data is shared safely and securely amongst providers and patients.
- **GW OHT Physician Recruitment**—<u>Dr. Ian Digby</u> represents GWPA with on this community table with health care, government and business leaders to consider what is needed to support robust physician recruitment to address the current and future needs of our communities.
