
ConnectMyHealth

Patients will soon be able to view their health records online!

By logging into ConnectMyHealth, patients will be able to see their results, reports and dictations from many healthcare facilities, including our local hospitals, in a single, consolidated view. They will be able to sign themselves into ConnectMyHealth and this will like-

ly be available to them in the next month or two. There will be no cost and no apps to download. Results and reports from community labs and radiology clinics will also be included in the near future.

Other key features of Connect-MyHealth include new results alerts, a customizable dashboard so that patients can organize the types of health records (modules) that are most important to them, and patient visits timelines which show scheduled hospital appointments. Pa-



tients will also be able to share their records with family and care


